Christmas will start on Monday 7th December with our own Christmas Day in school where the children will be making Christmas crafts

Christmas Jumper Day - Monday 7th December - pupils will be able to come to school in their Christmas jumper. There will be a £1.00 charge which will be donated to charity. Please pay using your child's SIMS pay account in the Events tab. Children should come to school in their school trousers/skirt and shoes. If they usually have PE on this day, PE will be swapped for a crafts session so please do not wear PE kit.

Christmas dinner - Monday 7th December - we will also have our Christmas dinner on this day. Please order and pay for your child's meal using your SIMS pay account. Order using the Events tab and payment can be made using the payment box on the front page. All Christmas meals must be ordered by Mon 23rd November to allow enough time for planning this event.

Christmas cards - due to the current situation we will not be opening our post box this year. We are suggesting that your child writes one Christmas card addressed to their class. This can then be opened in class and used to decorate the classroom.

Christmas parties - Friday 18th December - we will be holding Christmas parties on the last day of term with a Christmas games afternoon. Children can come to school in their own party clothes, eliminating the need to change. There will not be a charge for this event.

Christmas gifts and cards for staff - the gifts and cards which families send for staff at this time of year are very much appreciated and bring a smile, we are asking that this year children do not bring gifts into school for staff. The commitment and support we have received from our children and families is a joy in itself.
