Did you know that as parents/carers of school aged children, you are eligible to collect home testing kits (Lateral Flow Tests) for use by members of the child's household or childcare bubble?

These tests are to be used by people who don't have symptoms, and results should be recorded online. If a positive result is given on a home test, a confirmation PCR test would then need to be taken. Earrings/ Jewellery / Hairbands and Make Up In the interests of safety, jewellery should not be worn in school as it can be hazardous in some lessons. Pupils who have pierced ears may only wear small plain studs (not novelty earrings) but these need to be removed during PE and swimming lessons. If earrings are worn on PE days, and your child cannot remove them themselves, they will be covered by tape by a member of staff. Make up and nail varnish must not be worn in school. Nail varnish will be removed by a member of school staff. Small watches may be worn in school by pupils who are able to tell the time. If worn, watches will also need to be removed for PE and swimming lessons. Hairbands should be a plain green or a hair-coloured band. Large or decorated hairbands should not be worn.

## Packed lunches

School is an ideal setting to promote healthy lifestyles and therefore we have the following requirements for packed lunches:  $\square$  No sweets – a small fun sized chocolate/biscuit may be included as part of a balanced meal.  $\square$  Drinks may include fruit juice, flavoured water or milk based drinks. Fizzy drinks are not allowed.

## Water

All pupils are encouraged to bring a bottle into school each day that can be filled with water. This should be a clear plastic bottle and labelled with your child's name. Water bottles are available from the school office to purchase. Please do not send flavoured water into school. Wood End has a water only policy during school.

## Footwear

If boots or trainers are worn to school, then a change of footwear will be necessary for wear during the school day. Trainers can be worn at playtimes or dinner times but must be changed to school shoes in the classroom. In summer, black sandals may be worn, but not plastic jellies or strapless varieties.
