School Meals	Please pay in advance using your Sims Pay account if your child/ren will be having a school meal.
Packed	School is an ideal setting to promote healthy lifestyles and therefore we have the following
lunches	requirements for packed lunches: □ No sweets – a small fun sized chocolate/biscuit may be
	included as part of a balanced meal. □ Drinks may include fruit juice, flavoured water or milk based
	drinks. Fizzy drinks are not allowed.   Nuts - please refrain from sending these items as some
	pupils have allergies which may be life threatening.
Water	All pupils are encouraged to bring a bottle into school each day that can be filled with water. This
	should be a clear plastic bottle and labelled with your child's name. Water bottles are available from
	the school office to purchase. Please do not send flavoured water into school. Wood End has a
	water only policy during school.
Earrings/	In the interests of safety, jewellery should not be worn in school as it can be hazardous in some
