**Severn Trent assembly** - your child may have told you about a visit from Severn Trent Water on Monday.

Mr Crilly explained to the children about the importance of saving water and how they can help reduce the water used.

*Water is one of the most significant articles that a human needs to survive. We take unhygienic water from the river and then take it to a factory. They sterilise the water until it is drinkable. Then we send it subterraneous through pipes that transmit it to your house. It then comes through your taps. After it is used, it travels through the sewage.*

*It proceeds back to the factory then it is cleaned once again and deposited back in the river.*
